The President's Award for Excellence & Leadership (PAEL) is ACCCES' premier award. It is the highest honor that may be bestowed upon eligibility professionals. This award is presented to a nominee who has demonstrated leadership in California Community College Athletics Association (CCCAA) eligibility, along with a strong commitment to fostering a culture of access, ethics, innovation and service within the organization. Below are the procedures for the nomination of candidates. It is important to meet each requirement. Nominees shall be judged from the information provided along with this nomination form.

Criteria for Award

- a. The candidate must have a strong recommendation from their respective community college.
- b. The candidate must have served in the role of an Eligibility Specialist for five or more years.
- c. The candidate must have been an active and contributing member of the CCCAA/ACCCES
- d. The candidate must have demonstrated leadership in processing eligibility, along with a strong commitment to fostering a culture of access, ethics, innovation and service.

Procedures for Selection

- a. ACCCES President's Award Nomination form
- b. Biography
- c. Headshot
- d. Two letters of recommendation, which must describe the accomplishments of the nominee

Schedule

- a. December 1st – call for nominations sent to all A.C.C.C.E.S. members
- b. March 15th – all completed forms submitted to the A.C.C.C.E.S. president
- c. March/April – award announced at the CCCAA annual convention
